

How to add a gift to your will

Your legacy will empower anaesthesiologists to provide the safest possible care to their patients

What to do next - consider the type of gift you would like to leave to the WFSA

A share of your estate

Also known as a 'residuary legacy,' this is a percentage of what remains of your estate after all other gifts and expenses have been paid.

A specific sum

This is a gift of a set amount of money, also known as a 'pecuniary legacy.'

A specific item

This could be something of value such as jewellery, a painting, property, or shares

Talk to your Solicitor or Lawyer

We recommend that you discuss your will, and the type of gift you might like to leave to WFSA, with your solicitor or lawyer. The value of your gift to WFSA will be deducted from your estate before Inheritance Tax is applied, so it could reduce the amount of tax paid. Your solicitor or lawyer will be able to discuss how this may affect your estate and beneficiaries.
