

Donning and Doffing Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): Reusable Gowns

PPE guidelines are rapidly changing. Adhere to your institution's specific guidelines.

Don PPE outside of patient's room. Ensure hair is pulled back away from face.



3. Put on Respirator



Ensure gloves go over cuff of gown



Donning and Doffing Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): Reusable Gowns

Doff PPE, except for respirator, in patient's room. Remember gloves, face shield, front of gown and sleeves are CONTAMINATED. Wash hands immediately if you touch any of these surfaces with your bare hands.

1. Remove Gloves



Grasp glove in palm of hand and pull glove off

2. Perform Hand Hygiene



Discard glove in waste container or hold in other hand





Slowly and gently, slide finger under other glove, between glove and cuff of gown. Discard glove(s) in Avoid touching contaminated side of glove. waste container

3. Remove Gown - Avoid touching outside, contaminated surface of gown




4. Perform Hand Hygiene

Tie-in-back gown: Untie gown and pull down from head and away from body.




Wrap gown into ball with contaminated surface inside. Place gown in appropriate receptacle






Tilt head forward, grasp strap and gently pull strap over head, pulling face shield away from face

6. Perform Hand Hygiene




Grasp ear pieces behind ears and pull goggles away from face



Place eye protection in waste or recycling receptacle

With respirator in place, leave patient's room and enter anteroom or hallway.
